

## **Metroring stopped fearing Cologne repeat**

**A parliamentary committee has stopped plans for a Copenhagen Metro City Ring fearing building stability problems.**

The Parliamentary Traffic Committee has decided not to give Traffic Minister Lars Barfoed a mandate to further develop plans for a Metro City Ring, according to TV2 Lorry.

The unanimous decision was taken following a recent accident in Cologne in Germany in which a Metro construction project may have caused buildings to collapse.

Fears that the same thing could happen in Copenhagen made the Committee ask for more information and investigations.

It had been expected that the minister would be given the go-ahead to approve the DKK 15 billion project without changing the controversial location of stations at Gammel Strand, Kongens Nytorv and Marmorkirken Church.
